## Kona Community Hospital: Community Update - January 14, 2022

Aloha All,

Please keep COVID safety precautions in mind as we enter the long holiday weekend. The majority of Hawai'i's current surge in cases is the result of community spread.

<u>Parents</u>: Please see attached "Daily Wellness Check" from the Hawai'i DOE. They are seeking your help in keeping our keiki and schools safe.

<u>Antibody Therapies Update</u>: The Omicron variant is <u>NOT</u> neutralized by Regen-cove antibodies. We will have no antibody therapies available for the near future. Our pharmacy is ordering Sotrovimab, which will be effective against the Omicron variant. However, we have no information as to when to expect a delivery, or what the administration criteria will be.

<u>Visitors</u>: *No Visitor* policy has been reinstated as another measure to mitigate the potential for further exposure within the hospital. KCH will reopen to visitors when it is considered safe for patients and staff. We sincerely apologize for this inconvenience.


