

COVID-19 VISITOR GUIDELINES

WHO: Patients, vendors and employees to Kona Community Hospital

WHAT: In response to a surge in COVID-19 cases in our community, visitor restrictions have been reinstated.

Visitor restrictions are in effect at KCH as follows:

NO VISITORS ALLOWED: (Compassionate exceptions will be allowed on a case by case basis)

⇒ Everyone will be screened for fever, cough, or congestion. **Anyone** with signs of illness will ***not*** be permitted to enter.

Obstetrics Visitation:

- ▶ Patients are allowed ONE adult visitor/support person for the duration of labor & delivery.
- ▶ Post-Partum patients are allowed ONE adult visitor/support person for the duration of the hospital admission.
- ▶ Visitor/support people will be screened every 12 hours and documented on the Overnight Visitor Log.

Chaplain Visitation: Chaplain visits are suspended until further notice (exceptions will be decided by nurse manager on a case-by-case basis).

Outpatient Services: See box below.

WHEN: Effective December 29, 2021 until further notice.
