## **COVID-19 VISITOR GUIDELINES**

**PREVENTING INFECTION** 

- Patients, vendors and employees to Kona Community Hospital WHO:
- In response to a surge in COVID-19 cases in our community, visitor WHAT: restrictions have been reinstated.

## Visitor restrictions are in effect at KCH as follows:

**NO VISITORS ALLOWED:** (Compassionate exceptions will be allowed on a case by case basis)

 $\Rightarrow$  Everyone will be screened for fever, cough, or congestion. Anyone with signs of illness will *not* be permitted to enter.

## **Obstetrics Visitation:**

- Patients are allowed ONE adult visitor/support person for the duration of labor & delivery.
- Post-Partum patients are allowed ONE adult visitor/support person for the duration of the hospital admission.
- Visitor/support people will be screened every 12 hours and documented on the Overnight Visitor Log.

**Chaplain Visitation:** Usual Chaplain visits are permitted until further notice. Outpatient Services: See box below.
